Notes

Lord – there are in several places uncertainty as to whether the term ‘Lord’ is referring to God the Father or to God the Son

Jesus

- As the Christ, the fulfiller of God’s plan through crucifixion/resurrection
- Baptized in the name of Jesus for forgiveness of sins/believing
- Jesus (in heaven) as ruler
- Persecution of believers = persecution of Jesus – He is intimately present in the life of the believers
 - Suffering for Jesus is not just suffering for confession but for the message of the name of Jesus – 9:15, 26:9

“In the Name of Jesus”

- Represents the real presence and conveys/invokes His power and authority
 - Though in OT uses for God ‘the name of God’ can dwell in Zion and yet God be everywhere at the same time – thus the real ‘presence’ does not necessitate the bodily presence
 - Thus this phrase carries the meaning of worship, trust and belonging to Him
- Baptized
 - Based on above, baptism signifies the worship, trust and belonging to Jesus
 - Has less of a ‘someone has the authority to baptize you’ and more of the ‘I belong to Him’ meaning when used with baptism
- Preached/Proclaimed
 - Preached under Jesus’ authority
 - But in the sense of revealing what Jesus said, or would have said or the meaning of either
- Healed
 - When this happens, the power of Jesus is grasped, claimed, or invoked
 - Not just the right people, right name but also faith is necessary (cf. 3:16)
 - But also Gospel is necessary (19:13-20)
 - Healing not only accompanies Gospel, it flows out of it and almost becomes it (4:12)
